President Campbell called the meeting to order at 6:10 PM in the school cafeteria. There were a total of 8 persons who signed in at this meeting.

Ms. Bludau highlighted upcoming events during the Superintendent's Report, including the GT and Health/Safety School meetings. There would be achievement testing later in the month, and discussed a possible AED purchase for the school. In addition, Ms. Bludau mentioned another possible CPR training may be needed.

The minutes were read and approved with the motion being made by Christine Brown and seconded by Al Beard. All approved so the motion carried.

The treasurer's report was reviewed and approved with a motion made by Missy McCord and seconded by Christine Brown. The regular checking account was shown to have a balance of \$1,232.46 . The money market was shown to have a balance of 25,036.86. All approved so the motion carried.

Christine explained that there would be upfront printing costs based on the number of recipes, style, and the number printed for the cookbooks. After some discussion regarding the profit that would be almost twice the initial cost, Ms. Bludau suggested using some playground budget money to begin the project and later the profits may be used to fund a grant match if needed. Christine stated that she would begin gathering recipes for the books over the next month. A motion was made to proceed with the project completion by Missy McCord and seconded by Ms. Beard. All approved and the motion carried.

A report was made by Lolly Mican on the upcoming school-wide dance. The actual date was still to be worked out and a committee had been formed to handle all the details.

Also under old business, a motion was made by Al Beard to donate the leftover gravel donation from the Chili Supper to the 7th grade class to be used in a raffle for an upcoming trip to Washington, D.C. The motion was seconded by Lolly Mican. All approved and the motion carried.
