Christine Brown said she would check with Tana Jalufka regarding the sodas needed for the bar. Lolly Mican will pick up all the ingredients for the cotton candy machine. Mr. Beard reported that if the weather is cold; there will be no outside child patrol. Ms. Chumchal will put out the advertising flyers before the holidays. Ms. Mican reported that the auction is going well and it will begin at 7:00 pm. There were no other committee reports.
