Neil Campbell made a motion to have the upcoming cookbook sale profits deposited into the PTO general fund. Ms. Jaks seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried.

Also under new business, the proposed budget for next year was presented to the members for questions or clarifications. Shelly Webel made a motion to accept the proposed budget. Ms. Steffek seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried.

The amount of the scholarship contribution for this year was discussed. Neil Campbell made a motion to set the scholarship amount at \$50 per student. Mr. Wozniak seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried.

A drawing for the teacher's attendance prize for the meeting was drawn and went to Ms. Jaks' class.
