

Sweet Home Parents and Teachers Organization (P.T.O.)

May 11, 2004

President Campbell called the meeting to order at 6:10 PM in the school cafeteria. There were a total of 16 persons who signed in at this meeting.

Ms. Bludau highlighted upcoming events during the Superintendent's Report, including the awards day program that would include a special presentation by Ronnie Leck for citizenship awards. Also, Ms. Bludau encouraged all the parents to discuss the health and development topics at their homes in conjunction with the special classes being taught at the school.

The minutes were read and approved with the motion being made by Terry Hermes and seconded by Lolly Mican. All approved so the motion carried.

The treasurer's report was reviewed and approved with a motion made by Juliet Monk and seconded by Christie Talbert. Ms. Campbell pointed out that the next treasurer's report would reflect the disbursements of scholarship money for the class of 2004, and that there would need to be a vote at the first general meeting of next year to approve a proposed budget. Ms. Bludau suggested that the executive committee meet and create a proposal for all the members to vote or amend at the first meeting. All approved the report so the motion carried.

Under old business, the Spring Dance chairperson, Lolly Mican reported that the \$100 donation was not needed because she had plenty of donated food and items for the dance. She also stated that many of the sodas that were left over would be donated to the 7th grade class to be sold at the upcoming Tom-Tom parade to benefit their Washington, DC trip fundraising.

Also under old business, a motion was made for the acceptance of next year's officers as a slate vote including: Edna Chumchal as President, Lolly Mican as Vice-President, Tiffany Johnson as Secretary, Beth Campbell as Treasurer, and JoAnn Bludau as Parliamentarian was proposed by Christine Brown and seconded by Juliet Monk. All approved so the motion carried.

Next, a report on the cookbook fundraiser was given by Christine Brown, chairperson. She reported that there would be a 30 cent discount given for typing the

books. Also, there would be a \$2.50 cost upfront to print and the sell price would be \$10.00. This would offer a good profit for the organization. There were sample styles passed around for comments and the project was expected to be close to completion in the fall semester.

Under new business, Ms. Bludau recognized the staff members and the school board members for their years of service. They were honored with a certificate and a coffee mug filled with goodies. Ms. Bludau also commented on their dedicated service and what a valuable asset each was to the school.

Under closing business, there was discussion of needed purchases for the school that would be researched, and the projection of a possible playground match for the next year. It was noted that the Sweet Home Music Fest would be scheduled shortly after the beginning of school and a chairperson should be chosen quickly.

A drawing for the attendance prize for the meeting was drawn and went to Amy Hull's class.

The next P.T.O. meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 24th, 2004.

A motion was made by Bobbie Aikens to adjourn the meeting. Christine Brown seconded the motion. All approved so the motion carried.
