President Chumchal called the meeting to order at 6:10 PM in the school cafeteria. There were a total of 16 persons who signed in at this meeting. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

The Superintendent's report highlighted upcoming events in the school and the service-learning areas of the community. Ms. Bludau expressed a great Thank you to Mr. Reeves and all of his work with the art club who were painting the gymnasium, and "Happy Birthday" was sung to Ms. Jaks. The minutes were approved as read with the motion being made by Christie Talbert and seconded by Terry Hermes. All approved and the motion carried.

The treasurer's report was read by Beth Campbell. It was reviewed and approved with a motion made by Dawn Points and seconded by Judy Ms. Raz. The regular checking account showed a balance of \$980.02 and the money market checking account showed a balance of \$14,132.79.

Under old business, the scholarship revision committee reported that there were some changes made to the format of the information provided to all the new or returning parents of the district. There was also some discussion of revising some of the restrictions and including the wording to eliminate some current conflicts. The committee would make further changes and present a draft of the information at the next meeting. There was no update on the cookbook fundraiser project.

Under new business, Lolly Mican was not available, but Beth Campbell stated they would be happy to sell their tent to the PTO for use in concession stands as well as other events. Ms. Raz made a motion to purchase the tent for \$100. Christie Talbert seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried.

Also under new business, President Chumchal announced that Christine Brown would like a donation of a raffle item from the PTO. Various suggestions were made including a camcorder, television set, and a portable DVD player. Teresa Kristek made the motion to donate up to \$250 for the purchase of a raffle item. Christie Talbert seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried.

The Chili Supper sign-up sheets were passed out in the Thursday folders and put together to make one master list. Anyone who had not signed up yet, was encouraged to sign up at the
